







Week 3

Something new: Adding in a third (and fourth) color adds depth to the woven square. Depending on color choices some layers may blend together.

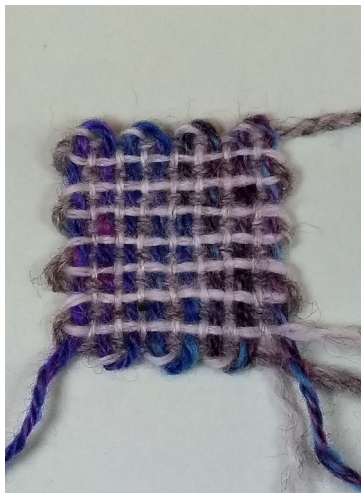
Refer back to Week 2 instructions if you want to minimize the number of ends.

<p>Square 3.2 Weave a square using Yarn A for layers 1 & 3, Yarn B for layer 2 and Yarn C for layer 4</p>		

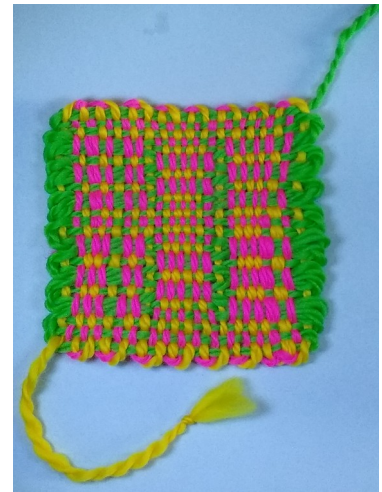
Square 3.3 Weave a square using Yarn A for layers 1 & 4, Yarn B for layer 2 and Yarn C for layer 3



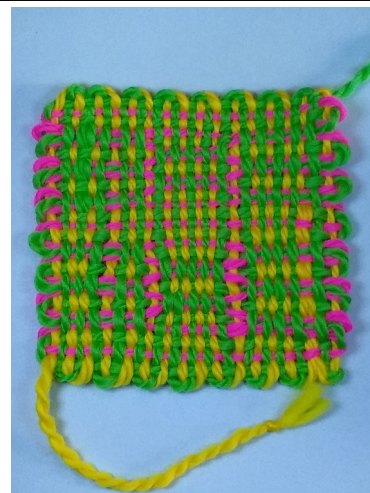
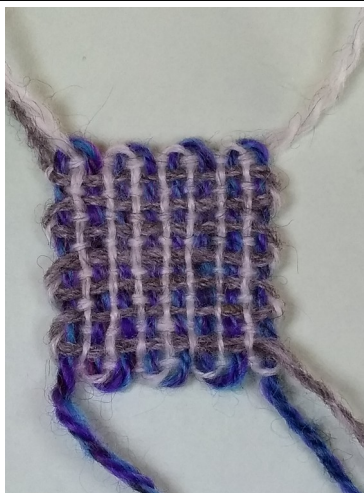
Square 3.4 Weave a square using Yarn A for layers 2 & 3, Yarn B for layer 1 and Yarn C for layer 4

Square 3.6 Weave a square using Yarn A for layers 3 & 4, Yarn B for layer 1 and Yarn C for layer 2

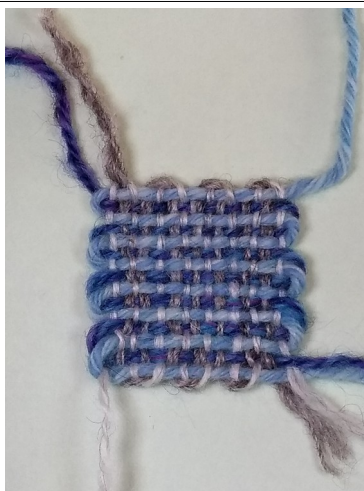

Square 3.7 Weave a square using Yarn A for layer 1, Yarn B for layer 2, Yarn C for layer 3 and Yarn D for layer 4



There are 256 different ways that 4 different colors can be arranged in the 3 layer warping on a pin loom where changes happen only at layers, everything from solid colors to using all 4 colors in the same square and how they are arranged in the different layers. The 16 squares that are completed follow only one color (color A) through some of its different versions, is there a variation that you think would look great. Give it a try and post your results along with your other finished squares.
